

Dear ePoster Presenter,

Your accepted e-poster has been selected to be presented during a Best Poster Presentations session, in addition to being shown on the poster viewing kiosks in the NASS Resource Center.

Best Poster Presentations sessions are casual discussion sessions. A large screen will be available to show your poster presentation, **but no other A/V will be available.**

You will have **ten minutes** to present your research and/or to answer any questions from attendees. We suggest planning to speak for nine minutes to ensure you do not go over your assigned time slot. NASS staff will be present at the poster presentation area to keep the schedule on time.

New This Year! Content Review Details

ePosters must be uploaded from August 1 – 31, 2010 for a content review by the Annual Meeting Program Committee, in an effort to reduce potential bias from being presented during NASS educational activities. The upload link will be sent to all Presenting Authors by email.

If you do not upload your presentation by August 31, your ePoster will NOT be presented at the Annual Meeting.

As a Best Poster presenter, you do NOT need to upload your ePoster twice. Only the latest uploaded presentation will be used.

Important Content Review Dates:

- August 1: Presenters can begin uploading presentations.
- August 31: Deadline for presentations to be uploaded.
- September 15: Required changes forwarded to Presenters.
- September 24: Deadline for required changes to be made and presentation re-uploaded.

The following requirements will be strictly enforced:

- Educational materials that are part of a CME activity, such as slides, abstracts and handouts, cannot contain any advertising, trade name or a product-group message.
- The content or format of a CME activity or its related materials must promote improvements or quality in healthcare and not a specific proprietary business interest of a commercial interest.
- Presentations must give a balanced view of therapeutic options. Use of generic names will contribute to this impartiality. If the CME educational material or content includes trade names, where available trade names from several companies should be used, not just trade names from a single company.
